On Saturday 4th July, Jacob completed the Snowdon Challenge and made it all the way to the summit! He didn't complain once and took everything in his stride!

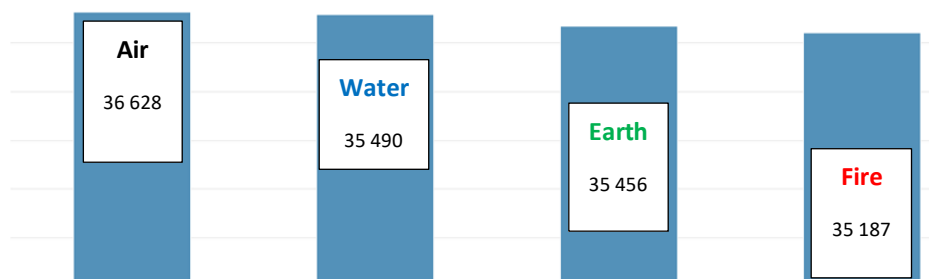
We are all very proud of you, Jacob - well done!
