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Parent/Governor Meeting

Wednesday 5th June 5pm – 7pm

Issue raised by parents:

1. Outcome of previous discussion around timings for school lunches.

Outcome:

• Headteacher had carried out observations around the timings for the school lunches and noticed that some of the older children weren't finishing their lunches on time. The headteacher has also spoken to the School Council about this. Therefore, school is currently reviewing timings of the school lunches.

Issue raised by parents:

2. Homework on the school website not being there over the weekend.

Outcome:

• Apart from one occasion where the homework did not appear until Monday afterwards, all home work has been put on to the school website by the end of the working day on Friday (6pm). There is a delay between the newsletter being sent out and the home work being published on the website but it will be there by *6pm every Friday*.

Issue raised by parents:

3. Bollards to stop parents parking near the entrance to school.

Outcome:

• School is currently investigating purchasing some mobile bollards/signs to raise the issue of not parking near the entrance to school.

Issue raised by parents:

4. A separate incident involving a parent's child.

Outcome:

- A reminder that if you have a personal issue that you would like to discuss, please follow the school's policy: First speak to the class teacher. If this does not resolve the issue, please make an appointment to see either Mrs Rogers or Mr Stevens. If you are still unhappy with the outcome, please make an appointment to see the Chair of Governors.
- These meetings are not for personal issues but rather comments about school processes and procedures and an opportunity to meet members of the Governing Board.
