Teams Classrooms

- 1. Log into RM Unify bromhillsdudley.rmunify.com
- Log into your child's account (Remember the username is your child's last name and the first letter of their first name, followed by @bromhills.dudley.sch.uk - for example: <u>smitht@bromhills.dudley.sch.uk</u>)
- 3. Type in your child's password (these have been sent out via text)
- Once you have logged into RM Unify, you should be able to see a tile called Teams – click on this (the first time you do this, you might be prompted to sign into an account – use the school account and then type in your child's username, as above)
- 5. Hopefully, you will be able to see the Teams classes. Click on a class and then on the tab assignments. Here you will find the homework.
