Reception

Welcome back! We hope you have all had a wonderful Christmas and a Happy New Year! The children have all returned to school full of stories about their celebrations and we have spent time sharing these with each other and discussing the similarities and differences between our celebrations. This is always a very busy term with lots of exciting learning opportunities, trips and visitors to school planned. Our first topic this half term is 'Polar Life'. We will be looking at the habitat and comparing it to our own. We will explore the animals and people that live there and how they adapt their lifestyles to survive. We will be sharing the story of 'The Penguin Who Learned to Swim' in our Talk for Writing sessions and the children will be using non-fiction texts to inform their writing this term. In our maths sessions this week we have been exploring 3D shapes and talking about their properties. We even completed some experiments to find out which of our shapes rolled. This term we will be encouraging the children to write more independently, they can try this at home writing cards, shopping lists, letters etc. Ask them to write words, then use their robot arms to chop up the words writing down each sound as they hear it. Don't worry they won't hear all of the sounds! Make sure they use their sound mat from the resource pack to help them. Catherine from Dudley Performing Arts is also back this half term and we will be learning how to keep a steady beat when playing a variety of different musical instruments.
