Things to do at home with your child:

Apps/websites –

Please Note – iPads/iPhones for 3 and 4 years olds should only be used for a maximum of 1 hour per day.

Personal Social and Emotional – board games/taking turns with a ball/ Simon Says game/Memory games.

Maths - Number hunt/matching number to quantity/counting songs/ counting objects/Shape hunt/naming shapes/shapes around the environment/hopscotch

Exploring Media and Materials – colour hunt/colour matching/building towers, tall, short/creating structures familiar places in the environment /shaving foam/shampoo/playdough (anything messy!)

Reading and Writing - identifying own name/writing or tracing name/Initial sounds of simple words – I spy/identifying letters S.A.T.P.I.N/rhyming words/Reading lots of books, talking about the pictures/characters etc/Nursery rhymes

Physical - bug hunting/digging/planting seeds, flowers/fine motor – playdough/threading/small construction/chalk/pens etc

Being Imaginative – pretend kitchen/animals/role-play games/car/trains etc/bubbles/design a boat for the bath

Understanding the world - Bake a cake/walks/decorating biscuits/nature walks/make a bird feeder.
