



To Parent/Carers,

Dough Disco! – use a ball of play dough(this is extremely easy to make using 5 ingredients) Play any music and get your child to do the following with the play dough in their hand. Roll it into a sausage shape, smack it, roll it into a ball shape, dive in (Use each finger to plunge into the play dough) and squeeze it.
