Anti-Bullying Week

This week, children have been thinking about bullying and what we can do about it. Each class have been thinking of an acronym that we can use as a school, to raise awareness about what they need to do if bullying happens. We will share these when they are finished. The definition of bullying is: *Behaviour by an individual or group, repeated over time, that intentionally hurts another individual or group either physically or emotionally.* It is the 'repeated over time' part that makes the difference between an isolated incident and bullying. As a school, we do not tolerate bullying and will act upon any instances of it straight away.
