As you know, we are tasked with providing home learning. Therefore, teachers have worked really hard, in a very short space of time, to get ready for this. We are providing the following:

- A morning welcome from the class teachers;
- A mixture of live and pre-recorded maths and English lessons in the morning and a topic lesson in the afternoons;
- An end of day chat with the class teacher to see how the day has gone.

Times of the above have been staggered, so that parents with more than one child should still be able to access each session. Each lesson will have an introduction and explanation from the teacher and then time for children to complete the work independently, offline and away from the computer.

Teams Classrooms – How to log on

To access the online lessons, please follow steps below:

1. Log into RM Unify – bromhillsdudley.rmunify.com
2. Log into your child's account (Remember – the username is your child's last name and the first letter of their first name, followed by @bromhills.dudley.sch.uk - for example: smitht@bromhills.dudley.sch.uk)
3. Type in your child's password (if you are not sure, please email school)
4. Once you have logged into RM Unify, you should be able to see a tile called Teams – click on this (the first time you do this, you might be prompted to sign into an account – use the school account and then type in your child's username, as above)
5. Hopefully, you will be able to see the Teams classes. Click on a class and then on the tab – assignments. Here you will find the work.
6. You will find a link to the lessons on 'Calendar' – click on the lesson when it is about to begin.
