PCR Tests for Children

Parents, carers and anyone else living with a school age child or young person are among the priority groups being given access to **free home lateral flow testing kits** to test themselves. These rapid tests help to identify symptom-free cases of coronavirus. Please note: **they should not be used on a person who feels unwell or someone with coronavirus symptoms.**

Additionally, the government are advising that **primary-aged pupils** should **not be tested with lateral flow tests** and, if they are symptomatic, or have symptoms of a sore throat, stomach ache or a headcold etc, should book a PCR test for the child straight away. Remember – do not use a lateral flow test.
