Issue raised by parents:	Outcomes:
<b>School Uniform Shop</b> – can this be open again?	School are more than happy to run a second-hand school uniform shop if parents are happy to come and run it every month.
Parent Readers – can parents come in and listen to children read?	We welcome all volunteers who come in and support staff with listening to children read, as this is really valuable. If you are interested, please let Mrs Rogers know. Thank you.
